

CS 10051 Lab Experience 1

A Glossary and Web Browsing

1. Objectives

- Become familiar with the general structure of the lab software
- Practice rudimentary skills that are used in most of the labs
- Learn to use application that allows you to maintain a glossary of terms
- Begin exploring the World Wide Web (in case you have never done that)

2. Background

The software consists of an application file and a folder containing some example programs. To run the software, click the “Start” icon, then select “Programs” menu; next select “cs10051” sub-menu. Then click the continue button. You should see the menu of buttons shown in Figure 1.1.

To begin the Lab Experience 1, click the **Glossary** button on your lab software menu. At this point, a new window will appear (See figure 1.2 in your lab manual).
