SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Authors should submit an electronic version of their work for review to Philip A. Wilsey, University of Cincinnati (philip.wilsey@uc.edu). Submissions should be a complete manuscript in postscript or PDF, formatted 12 pages single-spaced 12 point font. Submissions must be received by November 1, 2001. The email body should include title, authors' full names and addresses, a FAX number, and author email addresses. All manuscripts will be reviewed by members of the program committee. The IEEE CS Press will publish the IPDPS symposium and workshop abstracts as a printed volume and the complete proceedings on CD-ROM.
