**Grading: 30 points for social & ethical content, 10 points for writing**

In the class lecture on Wednesday 15 September, covering Sections 2.2-2.5 Quinn, we examined four moral systems. Write a one-page (minimum) to 1.5 page (maximum) essay that summarizes the basic theme that these four moral systems have in common [10 points], succinctly describes how they differ [10 points], and then explains why these four systems — which we will not really use for the rest of the semester — have such appeal [10 points]. [The remaining 10 points is for writing.]

Type your essay into a word processor such as Microsoft Word, Open Office, or Google Docs. At the top of the first page, type “Homework 2” and your name. Save the file in .DOC, .DOCX, or .PDF format, and use **your last name**, a dash, and “**Homework2**” as the name of the file — e.g., “Walker-Homework2.doc”.

Stay within the page limit mentioned above, and format the essay as follows. Use a 12 point font, and double-space your text. Do not add an extra line between paragraphs, but indent the first line of each paragraph. The text of this paragraph follows these guidelines.

Submit the .DOC, .DOCX, or .PDF file containing your essay to me electronically, via email to [walker@cs.kent.edu](mailto:walker@cs.kent.edu) or [rawalke1@kent.edu](mailto:rawalke1@kent.edu) with “Homework 2” as the subject of the email. I will reply to your email to confirm the receipt of your assignment.
